

Figure A2.1. Historical trends (2005 to 2016) of total annual rainfall and number of rainy days in Sinnar




Figure A2.2. Comparison of daily rainfall pattern of 2015 vs 2016. 2015-16 was a bad drought year (494mm rainfall) due to the cumulative effect of consecutive droughts in preceding years. In contrast, 2016 was a good rainfall year (739 mm). Dry spells during monsoons were seen in both years. In 2015, there were long dry spells in the beginning of the monsoon when water was already scarce from drought in preceding years while in 2016 the dry spell came after two months of good rainfall hence its impact was lower


